Guidance on the application procedure for the subsidized housing and nursing home will be given during the workshop.

**Interview Skills** - Join an interactive workshop on learning how to market yourself during an interview. You will discover how to answer tough interview questions, dress for success and fully prepare to meet the requirements of the employer.
