**Canadian Citizenship & Rights and Obligations** - Is it time for you to apply for Canadian Citizenship? **Canadian Import & Export System Introduction** (**THIS WORKSHOP WILL BE DELIVERED IN MANDARIN**) - This session provides introductory information about the Canadian Export and Import System including documents/things needed to prepare before importing/import process, duties and taxes, documents/things needed to prepare before exporting/export process.

**First Canadian Resume** - Your resume is often the first point of contact between you and an employer. If you are a newcomer to Canada and interested in how to write an effective resume for the Canadian job market, join our workshop where you will learn the basics of resume writing, how to highlight your skills and what the difference is between a resume and a CV.
